CBI operates as a volunteer, not-for-profit organisation which specialises in providing free and low-cost computers to disadvantaged communities, both locally and abroad. This is possible through dedicated volunteers who work with refurbishing donated computers and computer equipment to good working use.

Pillar has been more than privileged in assisting ComputerBank by donating the following:

- 176 computer towers;
- 20 laptops;
- 8 monitors; and
- numerous cables and computer mice.

This donation is consistent with Pillar's 'Environmental sustainability' strategic objective. Instead of these items going into landfill, this was a great second chance opportunity for equipment to be given a new purpose beyond their initial use.

"The morning was a massive success. We had some great helpers, mainly from the IT department and our Resource Efficiency Team, who look after Pillar's objectives on environmental sustainability," said Claudia Cerroni of Pillar's Resource Efficiency Team.

The team spent a portion of their day helping ComputerBank load the computer equipment into the truck.

"For us to be able to give something that could otherwise have ended up as landfill provides a second chance to those who really deserve it," said Cerroni. "Sustainability plays a great role in this exercise – not only does it provide a goodwill gesture, but it

should also make us think more about the ways we use resources at work and at home."
